




## Visiting the South West office

Entrance to St Thomas Court




Arts Council England offices are part of a building which is accessed via an intercom.



Press button '8' followed by 'enter', then 'call' to speak to someone who can 'buzz you in'. Then take the lift or stairs to the third floor. Turn left and press the door buzzer, and someone will let you in.

If you are unable to use the intercom system, please arrange to meet your contact at Arts Council England outside the building. It is also a good idea to exchange mobile phone numbers in case you need to change the arrangements.

The office is best accessed from Redcliffe Street, rather than St Thomas Street, as the pedestrianized road past the Seven Stars pub is cobbled, and blocked by pub tables and posts.

1. Taxi drop off and collect point
2. There are covered cycle racks opposite the County Court on Thomas Lane.

There are double yellow lines the length of Thomas Lane. Blue Badge holders may park against these for a maximum of 3 hours.

There is on-street metered parking in Redcliffe Street for a maximum of 2 hours.

The office has one allocated car park space which may be booked in advance. Please ask your Arts Council contact if it is available when setting up your meeting.
